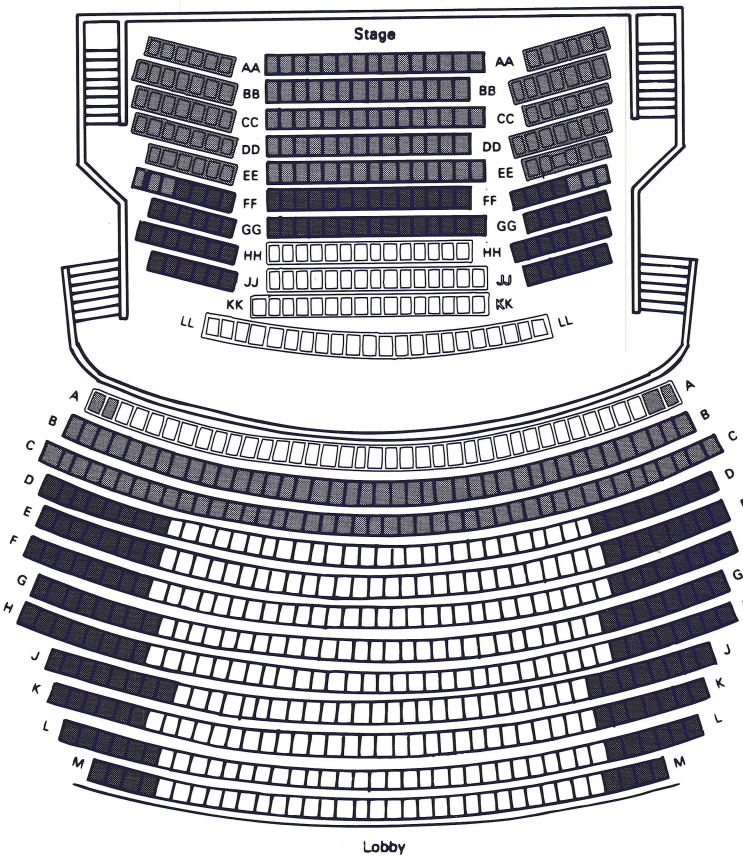


New! Preferred Seating for LJS&C Subscribers!
