German text:

Maria durch ein Dornwald ging, Kyrie eleison. Maria durch ein Dornwald ging, der hat in sieben Jahrn kein Laub getragen. Jesus und Maria.

Was trug Maria unter ihrem Herzen? Kyrie eleison. Ein kleines Kindlein ohne Schmerzen, das trug Maria unter ihrem Herzen. Jesus und Maria.

### **Sweelinck: Hodie Christus natus est**

Latin text:

Hodie Christus natus est: (Noe!) hodie Salvator apparuit: (Alleluia!) hodie in terra canunt Angeli, lætantur Archangeli: (Noe!) hodie exsultant justi, dicentes: Gloria in excelsis Deo. Alleluia! (Noe!)

English translation:

Rejoice, ye people of the earth, and praise God! The redeemer is come, whom the Lord has promised. He has revealed his justice to the world. Hallelujah!

English translation:

Mary wandered through a wood of thorns, Lord, have mercy. Mary wandered through a wood of thorns, Which was leafless for seven years. Jesus and Mary.

Who did Mary bear beneath her bosom? Lord, have mercy. A little babe without pain, Whom Mary bore beneath her bosom. Jesus and Mary.

The thorns had roses there, Lord, have mercy. As the babe was carried through the woods, There were roses with thorns on them. Jesus and Mary.

English translation:
Today Christ is born: (Noel!)
today the Savior has appeared: (Alleluia!)
today the Angels sing,
the Archangels rejoice: (Noel!)
today the righteous rejoice, saying:
Glory to God in the highest.
Alleluia! (Noel!)



## Victoria: O Magnum Mysterium

Latin text:

O magnum mysterium, et admirabile sacramentum, ut animalia viderent Dominum natum, jacentem in praesepio! Beata Virgo, cujus viscera? meruerunt portare Dominum Jesum Christum. Alleluia!

English translation: O great mystery, and wonderful sacrament, that animals should see the newborn Lord, lying in a manger! Blessed is the Virgin whose womb was worthy to bear the Lord, Jesus Christ. Alleluia!
