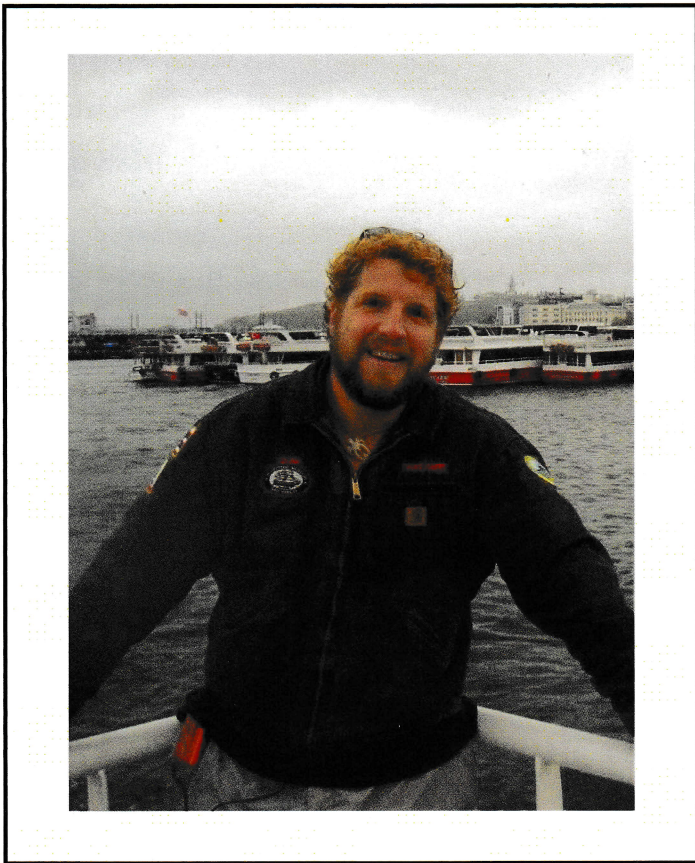

that you'll understand

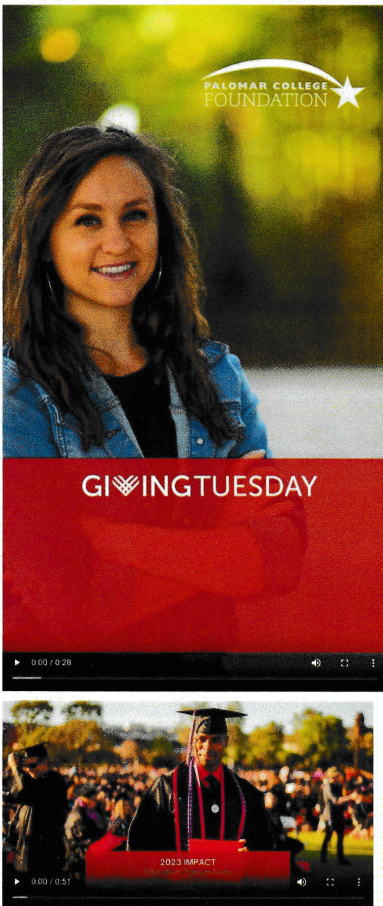
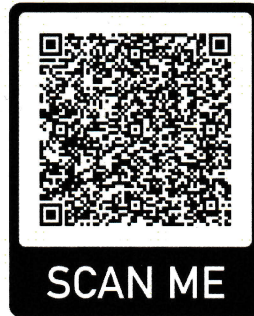

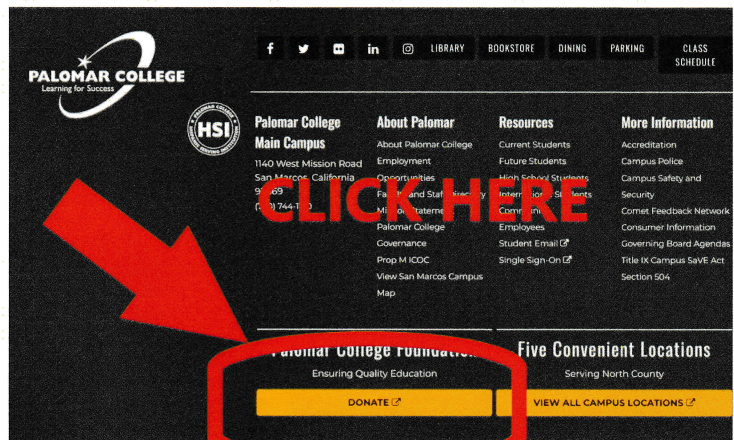
NATHAN DAUM MUSIC SCHOLARSHIP
