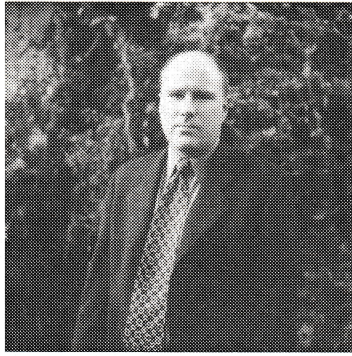


A FOND FAREWELL...
