About The Soloist

Cecil Lytle, currently chairman of the Music Department at UCSD, is equally at home in classical music and jazz. This diversity is reflected in his concert engagements: he has appeared as piano soloist with the Boston Symphony Orchestra and has also performed with James Brown, Arthur Prysock, and Carol Vaughn. The recipient of both a Fulbright award and a grant from the National Endowment for the Arts, Lytle has made numerous records on the Klavier and CRI labels; he is currently engaged in recording the piano works of Alexander Scriabin. This June he will make a tour of China, giving a recital in Beijing, and this November he will be piano soloist with the La Jolla Civic-University Symphony Orchestra in a performance of Scriabin's *Prometheus*.

1987-88 Season Announced

Details of the Association's 1987-88 concerts have just been announced. Highlights will include an all-Haydn concert in October, a program of mystical music in November (featuring a light-show with Scriabin's *Prometheus*), a program of American choral music in January, an appearance by San Diego violinist Frank Almond in March, and an all-French concert in May. Complete details and subscription information can be found in the form that comes with this program. A season subscription guarantees seating to all these concerts at greatly reduced rates, and you can subscribe by filling in the order form and either mailing it to our office or turning it in at the subscription tables in the lobby during intermission of this concert.

YOUNG ARTISTS CONCERT

The Association's annual Young Artists Concert will take place at 3:00 P.M. on Sunday, June 7, in Mandeville Auditorium. Appearing with the orchestra will be the winners of the Young Artists Competition in April: cellist Ling Yan, who will perform the Haydn *Cello Concerto in D Major*; clarinetist John Mula, performing the *Spoehr Clarinet Concerto No. 3*; pianist Hsiang-Lin Chu, who will perform the Grieg *Piano Concerto*; and two vocalists: soprano Dawn Veree Harrison and tenor Gerald Guy Monacelli, who will sing arias and one duet. The orchestra will open the concert with Dvorak's *Carnival Overture*.
