DIANA DAVIDSON, Mezzo Soprano

Miss Davidson received her Bachelor of Music degree from Oberlin Conservatory of Music where she studied voice under Helen Hodam. While at Oberlin she appeared in many operatic and choral productions. She has been soloist with the Claremont College Workshop, the UCSD Contemporary Opera Workshop and the Pacific Opera Theater. At present Miss Davidson is studying with Lara Browning in addition to working toward her Masters Degree at San Diego State University. As a winner in the 1972-73 Youth Talent Auditions sponsored by this symphony, Miss Davidson has been awarded a guest appearance with the La Jolla Civic/University Symphony.

KEITH HUMBLE, Guest Conductor

Keith Humble studied at the Conservatory of Music, Melbourne University and at the Royal Academy of Music in London; private tuition from Rene Leibowitz in Paris, with whom he subsequently worked as an assistant; founded and directed in 1960 the Centre de Musique at the American Artists Centre in Paris; returned to Australia six years later to an appointment in the faculty of Melbourne University where he was in charge of the Electronic Studio; member of the Australian Council for the Arts and conductor of the Contemporary Music Programs for the Australian Broadcasting Company; 1969 Regent's lecturer at the University of California at San Diego. Presently he is a member of the UCSD Music Faculty.

DAVID CHASE, Choral Conductor

David Chase received his Bachelor of Music and Master of Arts degrees in theory and composition from Ohio State University, where he was conductor of the Ohio State University Choir for two years and composer and arranger for the Ohio State University Chorale. His interest in new music led him to form the Contemporary Arts Choral Ensemble in Columbus, Ohio, and to participate in many experimental music concerts in that area. Mr. Chase's activities outside the choral idiom have included a national tour as Artistic Supervisor of the National Rock Opera Company, and the creation of a TV musical special for WBNS-TV, Ohio. For two years he was composer and musical director of the Ohio Theatre Repertory Company. Mr. Chase is presently an Associate in Music at the University of California at San Diego, conducting the Chamber Choir and the Civic/University Symphony Chorus.
